Study visits at companies, mentorship, lectures and great possibilities for information gathering and contact making has been provided through

	the Preface pilot course. The course has been based on a bottom-up perspective, and it has been developed in interaction with the female students who have drawn up proposals on how to structure the course.

Evaluation results (so far) (in 6 sentences)	The female students believe there is a lack of perspectives of entrepreneurship in several education programmes. The Preface pilot course has not primary focused on how to really take a business idea from concept to actual start-up. Though, the course has been appreciated by the students as it has orientated them about entrepreneurship.
